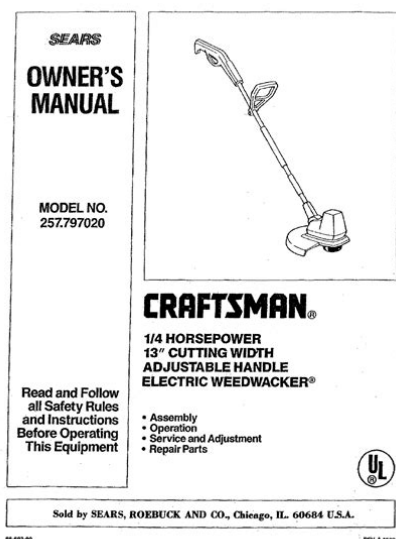

Loosen wing nut or knob on handle. 2. Rotate the handle on the tube to an upright position; place in a comfortable position and retighten wing nut. Lay the tool on a flat surface with the head facing toward you. 2 Pull the guide plate off the top of the head. Take out whats left of the old line, then clean the spool with a rag and replace the guide plate. Insert one end through one of the holes in the hub and the other end through the other hole. Pull the line to extend it all the way out. It should align itself within the positioning tunnels on the head. 4 Turn the head and pull the line out toward the safety guard. Cut off any that extends beyond the guard, using a knife. Cut the other line to the same length. Things Needed Knife Warnings Its important to cut both lines to the same length. When they are different, the head is unbalanced, and operating the trimmer could damage the clutch. Tips Use red line to trim grass and edge lawns, and black line to cut weeds and trim brush.
