From what I understand and feel free to correct me in the comments if I am wrong. So I purchased this Dell OVU400307 Remote Control IR because it had good ratings. I was very worried though because it didnt come with an IR Blaster not an issue because it wasnt listed as having an IR Blaster so I kind of had my doubts. However I used the IR Blaster from my old product and to my amazement and joy it just started working. I had to reconfigure the TV Setting in Windows Media Center. But it has worked perfectly ever since. It has solved my issue with the IR Blaster in the old unit locking up and not switching channels on the Cable Set top box to the correct program that I was wanting to record. Thank you for providing a decent product so I dont have to worry anymore about whether my TV programs will get recorded. There is only 1 remote setting that works on it and you need to find it by trial and error.

There are some functions that are missing that would have been very useful in a media center environment. I used AHK autohotkey to simulate these missing functions and it works well enough. Things such as live tv, info, guide, etc arent available as native functions. Needless to say, it works great. With a little coding you can even set the remote up to control the mouse while not in XBMC or Windows Media Center. The long cord helps in regard to placement, but my set up required a USB extension, which wasnt a big deal. Be warned, this product comes with no box and no instructions. It works out of the box with windows media center but if you plan to use it in any other ways, you will have to do some tweaking. I have a logitech harmony remote and i wanted to control my xbmcmedia center application in my computer from it. It was a little bit tricky to setup. I used 2 programs, one called winlirc to capture the signals and another one called eventghost to actually do something with them. After the pain of the initial setup, it has been working flawlessly. The cord on this thing is extra long too! I launch into Media Browser and I am able to use my Harmony remote to control just about everything. I was shocked that I didnt have to jump through thirteen hoops to get the thing to work. Its a little large, but has a nice long usb cable so you can stick it wherever you want.
