Attach the screw in the middle of the foot to secure the foot in place. Repeat the same steps for the second foot on the bottom right corner of the heater. Place the heater near a power outlet in a room. You can minimize the effects of a drafty window by placing the heater below the window, if you desire. Keep flammable materials such as furniture or cloth away from the heater. Plug the power cord into the outlet when ready for use. You can use one or both heating elements at any time, depending on how warm you want the room. When the pilot lights turn on, adjust the thermostat knob to the desired level. The heater will turn on and off depending on the temperature of the room and the thermostat setting. When the room temperature reaches the thermostat setting, the heating elements will turn off automatically. If the room temperature drops below the thermostat setting, the heater will turn on again. To clean the heater, turn off the heater and unplug the power cord. Allow the heater to cool off for several minutes. Once it is cool, wipe off the heater with a damp cloth. I was happy to purchase it, especially as I believe DeLonghi to be a reputable brand. Our experience has been disappointing to say in the least the heater makes a clicking noise constantly, not just when heating up or cooling down, but all through the night when turned on, making our sleep very disturbed. Also, the heat only radiates directly. Read more out of the top of the heater and due to the protective casing, no heat radiates from the sides of the heater.

Keep combustible materials, such as furniture, pillows, bedding, papers, clothes and curtains at least 3 feet 90 cm away from the heater's front and top, and also well away from its sides and rear. If you notice any leakage of oil, switch it off immediately and contact a service center as indicated in these instructions. Return the heater to an authorized service facility for inspection, electrical or mechanical adjustment, or repair. Never locate the heater where it might fall into a bathtub or other water containers. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners, or the like. Run the cord away from traffic areas and where it will not be tripped over.

Do not place the heater on soft surfaces, like a bed, where openings may be blocked. Therefore, you should not use it in areas where gasoline, paint, or flammable liquids are used or stored. Any other use not recommended by the manufacturer might cause fire, electric shock, or personal injury. However, exceedingly hot or deformed plug or cord are not normal, and are often the result of a defective power outlet. You should replace such outlets prior to further use of the heater. Continuous use of defective outlets might cause cord overheating and fire. However, where necessary, you may use a No. 14 AWG or larger cord rated for 1875 watts or more; the extension cord should not be shared by any other appliance. Please note that the quality of wall outlets may deteriorate over time. Check the electric plug periodically for signs of overheating or deformation, and in such cases, stop using that outlet and have it fixed. If necessary, remove such pieces using a vacuum cleaner. Make sure that the room where the heater is placed is well ventilated during this first operation. Soft crackling sounds are normal during the heater's first operation. The appliance is located in a well ventilated room during this operation. It is normal for the appliance to emit small crackling sounds when you turn it on for the first time. Turn the radiator upside down and rest on the polystyrene. Pull each wheel to check that it is correctly inserted. Fully unfold the castors by turning them outwards Fig. 4. Your heater will minimize the effect of cold drafts. This plug will fit into the power outlet only one way. This is a safety feature. If you are unable to insert the plug fully into the outlet, try reversing the plug. If the plug should still fail to fit, contact your electrician to replace your obsolete outlet.
